





Retired Colonel Terry Branham Colonel and Master Army Aviator US Army

Terry Branham enlisted and served 26 years active duty in the US Army and retired as a Colonel and Master Army Aviator. He served in Vietnam as a Cobra Attack Helicopter Pilot and Platoon Leader, was awarded the Silver Star and Distinguished Flying Cross. Twenty years later during the Gulf War he was an Apache Helicopter Squadron Commander and Apache Pilot leading the first Squadron sized Apache attack into Iraq.

Following Desert Storm he was promoted to Colonel and because of his extensive night operations experience, he was asked to lead the Department of State Air Wing for the U.S. Drug War in South America for over 2 ½ years. His unit of 13 Army Officers and 500 contract and host nation people with 60 Helicopters and 12 Thrush Spray Air-



craft were operating out of a Florida base and in Peru, Guatemala, Bolivia, Belize and Ecuador. They performed night assaults into the jungle to destroy cocaine labs, spray Cocaine and Heroin crops in the mountains and to capture drug cartel aircraft transiting drugs from and thru these countries. Terry managed an annual budget of \$31 million dollars supporting his team that would capture over 1 Billion dollars in drugs each year.

He and his wife Barb reside in Lakeville, MN and serve as a Marriage Mentor couple for Pre-Marriage Couples with Mercy Road Church and they have led an annual Free Christian Military Couples Marriage Retreat at the Miracle Lodge in Stewartville, MN for 9 years every April.

Prior to Covid, they were active as Volunteers at the Armed Forces Service Center at the MSP Airport and average 12-16 hours per month in the military lounge/center serving active military and retirees and their dependents. Terry served as the President of the 26-member Board of Directors for 3 years.

As the Volunteer Coordinator for the Lakeville VFW Post 210 Construction Team, Terry organized a team of retired Veterans and civilians with a heart for the military and they build Disability Ramps for Veterans across the entire Metro Area. They have built over 100 ramps to date in the past 10 years. In addition, the team has done scores of projects for Military and Veteran families while deployed and projects unaffordable to these families such as painting, bathroom remodel for wheel chair access, etc.

- Promote and support the NCTGA as a whole


